# Factsheet: Leg Two

## Boggart Hole Clough to Daisy Nook

### Description



The course contains an urban area sandwiched between two large and pleasant parks. The course is quite long - about 8.4 km - but with cafés in both Parks it does offer some comfort at each end.

Moston Brook is a delightful small river and the Rochdale canal adds further watery interest.

The shortest walking distance between the Start and Finish is 6.3km, but with 12 checkpoints the route stretches to about 8.4km.

There are decent sized car parks adjacent to both the Start (M9 7BR) and the Finish (M35 9WJ)

#### **Café and conveniences**

At Boggart Hole Clough, the Lakeside café is 400m down the drive from the finish point. The café is next to the Finish at the top of the Daisy Nook Country Park Car Park.

#### Safety

The A663 is a busy road about one third of the way into the course. The dual carriage way section is easy to cross since there is a wide grassy central reservation, even so the map has been marked with recommended crossing points. Checkpoint 4 is at a controlled crossing point where there is no central reservation.

### Transport

There is a variety of terrain, some of it is likely to be muddy, but most of the paths are hard standing.
